

# SUEDWIND FOOTWEAR

## HOW TO MEASURE OUR TALL BOOTS AND CHAPS

- Please sit in a chair with your knees at a 90 degree angle towards the floor.
- Wear your usual riding breeches and socks (no shoes).
- Have someone else measure your calves, if possible.

### Measurement:

#### A. How to measure your calf WIDTH:

The calf needs to be measured at the widest part.

#### B. How to measure your calf HEIGHT:

The height must be measured barefoot from the bottom of the heel up to the back of the knee (sitting on a chair).

### Example:

You measure 35 cm in width and 46 cm in height.

Which size do you have to pick?

Width  $35 - 1 \text{ cm} = 34 \text{ cm}$

Height  $46 + 2 \text{ cm} = 48 \text{ cm}$

The correct size to pick is 34/48.

### Tip:

- As tall boots and chaps tend to compress a few centimeters when in use, you should add 2 cm (as explained above).
- The shaft must fit tight. The leather will stretch at least 1 cm in width when use.
- Not all tall boots and chaps measure the same. Please check the remarks in the size chart per style.
